They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life; to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers.

Awe came upon everyone, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles.

All who believed were together and had all things in common; they would sell their property and possessions and divide them among all according to each one's need.

Each day they devoted themselves to meeting together in the temple area and to breaking bread in their homes.

They ate their meals in exultation and sincerity of heart, praising God and enjoying favor with all the people.

And every day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved.

From Hertford end points West: From 1-84
Eastbound, take I-384 East. At end of expressway, stay in the right lane, onto US-6 E
(Providence/Willimantic). Stay on US-6 E. Exit
CTI 95 / Storrs/University of CT. Go straight through the lights. At next light, tum right onto Rte-195. Turn right onto Jackson Street. Saint Joseph's will be on your left in .6 miles. Tum left at the light.
From points South: Follow CT-2 W to CT-32 N / Franklin Turnpike. Take exit 25 from CT-z W/CT-32 N. Follow CT-32 N to Jackson St in Willimantic. Tum right across the frog bridge and right at second light. Then immediate left to Saint Joseph's parking

From Rhode Island: Take US-6 W to State Hwy 632 in Mansfield. Take the exit toward Tolland 195 / University of CT Storrs from US-6 W. Tum right onto State H\*y 632 and rightontoCT-195 S (Ash St.). In .7 miles, tum right onto Jackson Street. Saint Joseph's will be on your left in .6 miles. Tum left at the light. From Boston and points East: Take 1-90 Mass. Turnpike to Sturbridge exit #9, I-84 westbound. Follow I-84 to Connecticut exit #70 for Rte 32 South toward Willington. In 7 miles, take a left onto Rte 195 West. Follow 195 to Willimantic. Tum right onto Jackson Street. Saint Joseph's will be on your left in .6 miles. Tum left at the light.
