**Directions to St. Luke Parish at

**Westbound, from Hartford/ I-84:**

Take Exit 32 Queen Street (Route 10) Turn right (south) coming off exit ramp onto Queen Street. Take first left onto Laning Street. Drive up hill about a mile. As road curves to right, take first left, which is the continuation of Laning Street. Drive about another mile to end which is Flanders Road. Turn right and the church parking lot is on the right.

**Eastbound, from Waterbury/ I-84:**

Take Exit 32 Queen Street (Route 10) Turn left (south) coming off exit ramp onto Queen Street. Take first (quick) left onto Laning Street. Drive up hill about a mile. As road curves to right, take first left, which is the continuation of Laning Street. Drive about another mile to end which is Flanders Road. Turn right and the church parking lot is on the right.

### What is it?

An ACTS retreat is a three-day, three-night Catholic lay retreat presented by men who have attended prior ACTS retreats, under the guidance of clergy. Retreat activities focus on Adoration, Community, Theology and Service. Scripture and the teachings of the Catholic Church are the guides. The goals are to renew yourself spiritually, to strengthen your faith and its application in your daily life, and to create lasting and supporting friendships. This is done via a positive, lively and interactive manner. Participants return to their parish faith communities with a deeper love for each other and a desire to become more involved.

The retreat begins Thursday evening, January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025 with 5:30pm check-in at St. Dominic Church, Southington, CT. Participants are transported to Our Lady of Calvary Retreat Center, Farmington, CT for the remainder of the retreat. The retreat will end on Sunday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025, with a 11:00am Mass and reception at St. Dominic Church. Transportation to and from the retreat center is provided.

The cost for the retreat is \$340.00. A deposit of \$170.00, made payable to St. Luke Parish, submitted with the enclosed form, will reserve your place. The remaining balance will be due at the Thursday evening check-in. You will receive a letter prior to the retreat describing the necessities to bring.
